Ambulance Walker	Single crewed vehicle. Can walk and access an ambulance via a side step or ramp with minimum assistance. Equivalent to the Walker with Assistance (W1A) category in the national criteria.	
1 Person Chair	(IPC) I Person Crew. A wheelchair will be available to transfer if required.	İ 7. 📫
2 Person Chair	(2PC) 2 Person Crew. A wheelchair will be available to transfer if required. Equivalent to the Double Crew 2 (DC2) category in the national criteria.	İİ 7. 📫
In Own Chair 1 Crew	(TIOC1) 1 crew ambulance. Patient travels in own chair. Equivalent to the Wheelchair 1 (WC1) category in the national criteria. Please use the Equipment tickboxes if the patient is travelling in an Electric Chair.
